THE FEE INCLUDES:

REGISTRATIONS

For registration the students require the following documents:

- * Evaluation of the students Spanish level
- * Copy of the School book (the last three years) officially translated in Spanish (by the Consulate or other Official organism)
- * Medical certificate
- * 4 pass sized photos and
- * A photo album with approx. 10 photos of the student with his / her family and friends.

THE PRICE DOES NOT INCLUDE:

- * Transportation from the student's country to Malaga
- * Text books and school material
- * Pocket money
- * Transportation in Malaga during the school year
- * Extra options / choices at the school
- * Private lessons when necessary
- * Any additional charges like cost of issuing legal documents, registration tax, courier services, etc.

Extra charges:

The school provide bus transportation for those who live not in the near area: 45€ monthly for a two-way transfer.

Student Exchange Program Spain

Following the 1990 reform, compulsory secondary education (ESO) lasts for four years (from 12 to 16) divided into two twoyear cycles (from 12 to 14 and from 14 to 16) and leads to the Graduado en Educación Secundaria Certificate. This certificate is required for a) Bachillerato studies (16 to 18) and b) intermediate vocational training (Ciclos Formativos de Grado Medio). Bachillerato students who have completed all subjects successfully are awarded the Título de Bachillerato. To enter university, students must sit for an entrance examination (Prueba de Acceso a la Universidad or Selectividad).

THE FACILITIES

Colegio Maravillas has modern and bright facilities. In addition to large and nice classrooms, there is a dining room, a barcafeteria, library, common rooms, teachers' room, secretary offices, a laboratory for biology, for physics and chemistry classes, a computers room, a small theatre and a room for the drawing classes.

A covered sports pavilion, more sport fields outside and a swimming pool are also on the premises.

The new school building was opened in September 2000 – and is located only few minutes walk from the beaches.

THE ACCOMMODATION

The accommodation is in selected host families, most of them are parents of our own students. The families live close to the town centre and approx. 20 minutes walking from the school.

Accommodation is provided in single rooms and on full board basis: all meals with the host family.

The host families will look after the foreign students at all times, will be in charge of their well-being, supervision, etc. They will also take care of their laundry.







COLEGIO MARAVILLAS – PRIVATE HIGH SCHOOL

Colegio Maravillas, a secondary school officially recognized by the Ministry of Education and Science of Spain (No. 29001650), offers foreign students the possibility to attend the academic year on its premises in Benalmádena, on the Costa del Sol.

Foreign students are admitted in these courses:

1st year of BACCALAUREATE (approx. Age: 17) **2nd** year of BACCALAUREATE (approx. Age: 18)

The lessons take place from Monday to Friday, from 08:30 to 14:30, except in September and June when they start at 09:00 and end at 14:00 hours.

The main school holidays in Spain are:

2 weeks at Christmas, one week at the end of February (semana blanca) and another week for the Easter vacations. The school also closes on local and national bank holidays.

Schools in Spain begin in mid-September and finish around June 23rd. Students attend primary school (colegio) until 6th grade. They then enter ESO for 4 years, followed by 2 years of university preparatory courses called **Bachillerato**.

The Spanish take more subjects in a week than most EU or US students. And the students' schedules vary from day to day. The classes are also more theoretical, and students are expected to study quite a lot outside of the classroom.

The students must all take certain core classes, which include: Spanish Language, Spanish Literature, Foreign Language, Philosophy, and Physical Education. Additionally students must choose one optional area from within 2 groups: Humanities and Social Sciences, Health Sciences and Technology. More information about these classes will be given to the students once on program.
